

DATA PROTECTION NOTICE

MSC Mediterranean Shipping Company SA having its registered office at Chemin Rieu 12-14, 1208 Genève, Switzerland (referred to as the “MSC” or “we”), acting as data controller in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Swiss federal Act on Data Protection 1992 (referred to as “Data Protection Laws”), is committed to protect the privacy and security of your Personal Data (as defined in section 2 of this document).

This data protection notice (referred to as the “Notice”) describes how we collect, use, share and transfer (together referred to as “Processing “or “Process”) Personal Data for the Purposes specified below.

Please also refer to our [Privacy Policy](#) which specifies the information we collect about you when you visit our website.

1. WHAT PERSONAL DATA DO WE COLLECT FROM YOU?

Personal Data is any piece of information relating directly or indirectly to You. MSC may Process the following categories of Personal Data about You:

- Name and surname
- Professional email address
- Professional telephone number
- Organization to which you belong
- Job Title and Department
- City and Country
- Main Industry
- Document type (B/L number, MSC code or Intra code)
- Reference number and business unit card including the business unit ID number (this number is meant to verify if you are already an active customer on our systems).

2. HOW WILL WE USE YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

We will only use your Personal Data to (1) identify you as an employee of, or as an existing MSC customer, (2) allow your company to get registered with the Service Provider which will provide the services requested, and (3) maintain our relationship with you and your Company (referred to as “Purposes”).

As permitted under Applicable Data Protection Laws, MSC will rely on its legitimate interests to Process your Personal Data. To ensure your interests, rights and freedoms do not override our legitimate interests, MSC will carry out a balancing test as needed.

Your Personal Data is required to meet the Purposes. If you do not wish to provide us with such data, MSC, and ultimately the Service Provider may not be able to provide the services requested.

MSC will only Process your Personal Data for the above Purposes. If we need to use Your Personal Data for an unrelated Purpose, we will notify you and we will explain the legal basis which allows us to do so or obtain your consent where required under Data Protection Laws.

MSC will not keep your Personal Data for longer than necessary to meet the Purposes.

3. DISCLOSURE OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

We may disclose your Personal Data strictly for the Purposes aforementioned to the following recipients, as described in the below list, who are required to take appropriate security measures to protect your Personal Data. They will only Process your Personal Data for the Purposes and upon legitimate interests.

- WAVE BL (the Service Provider); and
- MSC Agencies operating on behalf of MSC Mediterranean Shipping Company SA. (In particular, the MSC Agency operating in the country where you operate business).

We may also disclose Your Personal Data to a third party when it is required by the applicable law, court order or governmental regulation and when it is necessary to detect and prevent a fraud or support any legal investigation or proceeding.

INTERNATIONAL TRANSFER OF DATA

When Processing your Personal Data for the Purposes, either the Service Provider will transfer your Personal Data to MSC, or MSC will transfer such data to the Service Provider as strictly needed to provide the requested services and as described in the relevant policies. Your Personal Data is stored mainly in Europe. Your Personal Data may also be shared with MSC Agencies located worldwide to the extent necessary to meet the Purposes.

When we transfer your Personal Data outside the European Economic Area or Switzerland, MSC ensures that appropriate safeguards have been implemented under Data Protection Laws.

4. DATA SECURITY

We have put in place appropriate technical and organizational security measures to protect Personal Data against accidental or illegal destruction, accidental loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure or unauthorized access, notably when transferred to another country, and against any illegal means of Processing.

5. YOUR RIGHTS OVER YOUR PERSONAL DATA

According to the Data Protection Laws, you may exercise the following rights:

- Request access to Your Personal Data
- Request correction of the Personal Data that we hold about You
- Request erasure of Your Personal Data. This enables You to ask us to delete or remove Personal Data where there is no legitimate reason for us continuing to Process it
- Object to Processing of Your Personal Data
- Request the restriction of Processing of Your Personal Data
- Request the transfer of Your Personal Data to another party in a common readable format where it is practicable.
- Right to withdraw Your consent if the Processing of Your Personal Data is based on it.

In addition to the rights aforementioned and in compliance with the Data Protection Laws, you are entitled to lodge a complaint with the applicable data protection supervisory authority.
